Universal Run : Furumachi Juujiro 【Start·Finish】 ⇔ Bandai Bridge east end
Circular course (one lap = 2km)

▶ Race Rules and Operations

Marathon : The race will be held according to the competition rules stipulated by the Japan Association of Athletics Federations (Public Interest Company) 2025.

※ Sole Thickness Regulations

Men who finish the course in under two hours and 21 minutes and women who do so in under two hours and 56 minutes will have the thickness of their soles measured. Their time will not be officially recognized should their shoes not conform to the official regulations.

Fun Run : The race will be held according to the competition rules stipulated by the Japan Association of Athletics Federations (Public Interest Company) 2025.

Universal Run : Admission (9:00 - 10:40) Participants will be allowed to run or walk their desired amount of time/distance inside the course. Once registered, participants will be allowed to freely enter the course during admission time.

▶ Starting Positions

Marathon Fun Run : (1) Starting block assignments will be based on the estimated course completion time declared at registration (Assignments will be done regardless of registration status with the Japan Association of Athletics Federations. Both races will begin at the same time.) Please make certain to declare a realistic completion time based on your running abilities as not doing so may be dangerous and cause collisions with other runners and falls at the start. Those who fail to declare a completion time will be assigned blocks at the back.

(2) Depending on your starting block, it may take up to 20 minutes to reach the starting line after the starting gun.

Universal Run : At the starting gun, participants will start in order while maintaining proper distance from others.

▶ Result Timing

Marathon Fun Run : (1) The results of the race (including the recording of award recipients) will be recorded as the gross time from the starting signal to crossing the finish line.

(2) Times will be recorded at the following points:

Marathon / 5km, 10km, 15km, 20km, the middle point(21.0975km),
25km, 30km, 35km, 40km, the finish line

Fun Run / 5km, 10km, the finish line

(3) The finishing order and times will be decided using timing tags. Please take care as failure to wear or improperly wearing the timing tags will result in times not being recorded.

(4) The timing tags and athlete bibs will be sent by mail to participants by the end of September.

(5) Finisher certificates must be downloaded online and will not be handed out during the marathon.

Universal Run: Finishing times will not be recorded.

▶ Prizes and Awards

Marathon Fun Run: The following prizes will be awarded for both events. Certificates and prizes will be sent by mail the day after the event.

- Overall men and women finishers 1st – 8th place
- Age group awards – men and women 1st – 3rd place (overall finishers excepted) (participants 29 and under, in their 30s, 40s, 50s, 60s, 70 and over)

Universal Run: Prizes will not be awarded.

▶ Cut-off Checkpoints / Things to Know Before the Race

Marathon Fun Run: (1) Cut-off checkpoints will be set up along the courses and closed at predetermined times to ensure participant safety and the smooth flow of regular traffic. After a checkpoint is closed, participants will not be allowed to pass through and continue in the race. Please also note that the referees may also signal participants to retire from the race if they are judged to be severely behind even before checkpoint closures.

(2) Emergency vehicles may enter the course in case of emergencies such as accidents, fires, sudden illnesses and so on. This will cause the referees to pause the race. Please be aware that these occurrences or anything delaying the starting gun will not affect result timing nor checkpoint closing times.

Universal Run: After the end of the event, please exit the course in a timely manner, for example by moving to the sidewalk.

▶ Finisher Prizes

Marathon Fun Run: A finisher towel and either a jumbo rice ball or a pack of microwavable rice.

※ The Marathon and Fun Run will have different towels.

▶ Baggage Check-In

Marathon Fun Run: (1) Baggage and belongings may only be checked in before the event using the bags furnished (height 60cm×width 60cm×length 5cm).

(2) The organizers of the event will not take any responsibility for the theft, loss or damage of valuables. Participants are asked to please take care of their valuables.

(3) Baggage checked in before the race will be taken to the finish line by the organizers. Delivery may be late due to factors such as traffic congestion.

Universal Run: Baggage excluding valuables may be checked in at the venue during the event.

▶ Participation Prizes

Marathon Fun Run: Participants may choose from one of the following three items: a custom Niigata Marathon [A] running cup [B] running cap [C] tote bag.

※ Cancellations no changes will not be accepted once registration is completed.

▶ Issuance of Bibs and Other Items

The following will be sent to participants by mail near the end of September:

Those who applied through Run Japan will be contacted by email with instructions on how to receive the following items.

Marathon Fun Run: Athlete bibs, timing tags, participation information, participation prizes, baggage check-in bags, etc.

Universal Run: Athlete bibs, participation information.

Please be advised that the organizers will not take responsibility for any late or undelivered items or material due to address input errors during registration or circumstances during shipping. Should you wish to change your address after registration, please do so on the Runnet website main page and notify our offices before the end of July.

▶ Racing Attires

Clothing and accessories that violate social standards and may be dangerous or intimidating to other participants are forbidden to be worn, held or displayed at all venues, courses included. This includes walking poles, flags and banners, clothing or accessories made with metal wires, attires and accessories advertising religious or political content, and advertisements of companies or products unless

permission is granted by the organizers. The organizers reserve the right to deny participation based on these guidelines and will not acknowledge any arguments or complaints on this topic.

► **Getting to the Venues by Public Transport**

Marathon Fun Run: (1) Paid parking will be provided around the starting venue on the day of the event (October 12th, 1100 yen (tax included) per vehicle). Because space is limited, participants wishing to use these paid parking spaces are required to reserve one during registration (Spaces will be allotted in order of registration.) Cancellations or extra reservations after registration are not allowed.

(2) A free shuttle bus will be in operation on the day of the event.

Before the event: JR Niigata Station (south exit) ⇒ Denka Big Swan Stadium

After the event: ① Niigata City Athletic Stadium ⇒ JR Niigata Station (south exit)

② Niigata City Athletic Stadium ⇒ Denka Big Swan Stadium

(3) The organizers will not acknowledge any lateness caused by traffic conditions or using public transport.

Athlete Bibs With Nicknames

- Nicknames may be added to athlete bibs for an extra 550 yen (five characters maximum).
- Please enter the desired nickname during registration.
- Nicknames will not be allowed if they are deemed to be inappropriate by the organizers, for example names of companies or products, and the extra fee will not be refunded.
- Does not apply to registered members of the Japanese Association of Athletics Federations.

▶ Entry Terms and Conditions

Participants will be required to accept the following terms and conditions upon entry:

- (1) If found to have applied for multiple events at the same time or falsified information during the registration process, participants will be disqualified and the organizers will not provide any compensation or refunds.
- (2) After entry, participants will not be allowed to modify, correct or cancel any of the entered information.
- (3) Participants are not allowed to falsify names, ages or gender on their applications, nor is anyone other than the entrant allowed to participate (for example substitute runners or transferring entrant status to another party). Participants found to be in violation of this will be disqualified, the organizers will not offer any form of refund or compensation, and the disqualified entrant will be banned from entering future Niigata City Marathons.
- (4) Please make sure to input your address (including the building name, room number and other information) and email address accurately when registering. The organizers will not be held responsible for any undelivered or late materials or emails due to errors during the registration process (for example mistakes in your Sports net ID, your Runnet registration information).
- (5) The organizers will not be held responsible for any loss of items, illnesses or any other incident occurring during the event, unless they are found to have somehow acted in bad faith or committed gross negligence.
- (6) Should an illness or injury occur to a participant during the events and said

participants agree to receive first aid, the organizers will not be held responsible for the methods and carrying out of said first aid.

(7) Participants will be automatically covered by accident insurance by the organizers. However, please be aware that COVID-19 infections do not fall under the coverage of this insurance.

(8) Should the events be canceled or their scale reduced by circumstances out of the control of the organizers, for example earthquakes, wind of flood damage, lightning strikes, accidents, illnesses or other incidents, any refunds and the amount refunded (including if entry fees will be refunded at all) will be decided at that time in consideration of criteria such as expenses already incurred (In the case of the scale of the event being reduced, this will only apply to entrants having been asked to not participate by the organizers.)

(9) Participants are being asked to have properly trained for the event and received all the necessary medical examinations to ensure they are in proper condition to compete.

(10) The organizers will take absolutely no responsibility for any lateness or inability to reach the events due to public transport delays or traffic conditions. Entry fees nor any other charge will not be refunded.

(11) The likeness and publication rights of filmed footage, photographs, records, the names, age and address of entrants (limited to their prefecture and city of residence) in any medium such as newspapers or the internet shall be attributed to the organizers.

(12) The organizers understand the importance of protecting private information and will handle any such information in compliance with the Act of Protection of Personal Information and any other related law. Please note that personal information may be shared with public health centers for goals other than the operation of the event, such as measures to prevent the spread of infections and diseases.

(13) Participation information, record notifications, notifications of related information, information about the next Marathon, Marathon sponsorships and cooperation, provision of services from related organizations, ranking announcements and surveys may be used by Marathon officials with the goal of improving their services.

(14) The Marathon is being held in compliance with all relevant national laws.

(15) Minors must receive the approval of a parent or guardian before entering.

(16) The organizers will not be held responsible in any way for any late or missing applications or payments due to problems with internet devices or connections.

(17) Online registration may not be available due to the device, operating system or browser used.

(18) Please follow any other directions by the organizers to ensure a safe and secure

event.
